



**I wanted to get some info on holding a tournament at your facility. I would like to see the course & speak with someone, what would be a good day?**

If you just want to come out and see the Clubhouse, Pavilion, and golf course, you may come whenever you wish; however, if you would like to speak with a manager it would be best to set an appointment.

**Can we bring (or have donated) our own alcoholic beverages?**

No, per Army regulation, you must buy the alcohol from us; we sell beer, wine, and malt beverages by the case.

**How do the beverage cars work?**

All alcohol must be distributed by a Moose Run Golf Course employee – if you rent a beverage cart and intend to provide alcoholic beverages, we will provide an employee for you. After your tournament any extra beverages not used during the golf portion can be brought to the Pavilion area for the awards lunch.

**What if I have less than 132 (or 72) players?**

You will be charged for 132 or 72 players, but not for the extra golf cars.

**We are a non-profit, can we get a discount?**

We do not generally offer discounts on tournaments.

**Can golfers get their golf cars early the day of play?**

For a shotgun tournament, all the golfers get their carts at the same time. For a tee time tournament, golfers will get their carts when they check in.

**Is there a charge for the Picnic Pavilion?**

There is no charge for the Pavilion – if it's available, and if you're having a tournament here.

**Some sponsors want to "prepay." Is that possible?**

Yes, they can pay whatever amount they want towards the tournament, in advance. That amount will just be credited against your bill. Contact the manager if you would like to do this.

**Will the golf course donate gifts?**

Gifts are donated on a case-by-case basis, please speak with the manager.

**Can we start later than 7:00 AM?**

Not for a shotgun tournament. Tee time tournaments may start whatever time of day that has been specified with the manager.

**Can we have an afternoon shotgun start?**

Afternoon shotguns are granted on a case-by-case basis, please speak with the Assistant Manager or the Business Manager.

**Can we get extra golf cars for our volunteers?**

Yes, you can, but they will cost the same as the golf cars for the golfers.

**Who will put out the special events signage?**

Our Recreation Aids or a Supervisor will put out the signs before the tournament unless you wish to do so yourself.

**Can we come out the night before and set up?**

If you would like to set up the night before, it needs to be set up with a Supervisor beforehand.

**Can we bring our own food in the morning or for the picnic, or do we have to buy from Moose Run?**

You may bring your own food if you wish; however, if you would like Moose Run to cater your event, please contact us at least 10 days in advance.

**Do you have ice?**

We do have an ice machine, but ask that you bring about six bags of ice the morning of your tournament to get you started. We go through a lot of ice (especially on hot days).

**Is there power at the Picnic Pavilion?**

We can provide a generator – please specify if you'll need it on your Tournament Contract.

**Where can we post score sheets?**

We have a scoreboard than you can use – please specify if you'll need it on your Tournament Contract

**I've never run a golf tournament before. What do you suggest?**

Please look at our "Tips on Running a Successful Golf Tournament." Also, you can always come out for another tournament to see how they do things.

**Can we return beverages we don't use? If we run out can we buy more?**

You may not return any opened cases. You may buy as many cases as you like.

**When do the golfers head out to their starting holes?**

For a shotgun start, the golfers will be released to go their holes about 10 to 15 minutes prior to the start of the tournament.

**Does someone tell the golfers when to start, or is that our responsibility?**

For a shotgun start, we will release the golfers to their holes and we will sound the horn for the start of the tournament.

**How much are green fees and carts this year?**

The fees vary from year to year. We won't know until spring 2010 what our fees for the 2010 season will be; however, they don't tend to vary by much.

**How much is the course charging for beer/wine/liquor this year?**

Please ask the manager for a beverage pricing sheet. The same rule applies to beverages as to green fees; the prices may vary year to year, but they don't tend to fluctuate too much.

**Is it ok that we set our sponsors signs out the night before?**

If you would like to set up the night before, it needs to be set up with a Supervisor beforehand.

**Is it ok to bring coffee? Water?**

We can provide coffee and water for you, please specify on your contract if you'll need it. Otherwise you may bring your own coffee and water.

**Will the snack shacks be open?**

The snack shacks will not be open during any tournaments that have beverage cars. If you opt not to have beverage cars for your tournament, the snack shack will be open for your golfers to purchase refreshments.

**Can we bring out the Hole-In-One Cars the night before?**

If you would like to set up the night before, it needs to be set up with a Supervisor beforehand.

**Do you have the large score sheets for posting tournament scores?**

Yes, please ask the manager to provide them for you.

**How does a 1/2 shotgun work?**

For a 72 player 1/2 shotgun, this is where you start:

1 A&B

11 A&B

12 A&B

13 A&B

14 A&B

15 A&B

16 A&B

17 A&B

18 A&B

*IF YOU HAVE 80 PLAYERS, USE #10 AS WELL.*

## **We're having a Hole-In-One Hole. What yardage should we use for the insurance company?**

You'll want to use the yardage provided on our scorecards for the Par 3 holes. **DO NOT EXCEED YARDAGE ON HOLE-IN-ONE HOLES.** The yardage is important because many tee boxes do not afford to be "lengthened." Sometimes insurance companies will give a "break" at a certain yardage – but the yardage is very important, not to exceed these distances:

Hole-in-One (Hill)  Hole # 2 - 157 yards  Hole # 6-140 yards  Hole # 14 -162 yards

Hole-in-One (Creek)  Hole # 3 - 165 yards  Hole # 6-149 yards

Hole # 15 -128 yards  Hole # 17 – 176 yards

Also, check your insurance contract carefully. Often it says you need 2 Hole in One spotters. It may also allow you to have women 15-20 yards closer than the men.

## **What if it's raining?**

We play anyway! If you choose to cancel your tournament, you will still be responsible for paying the minimum amount of golfers and carts.

## **How many people will the Pavilion hold?**

144 people comfortably

## **Do you have a BBQ we can use?**

Yes, it costs \$60 to rent and it comes with BBQ tools.
